Come learn more about our Research & Mentoring Fellowship (RMF). We established RMF to support underrepresented or first-generation undergraduate students engaged in a collaborative relationship with research mentors for a five-week summer research project fostering self-advocacy and professional development.

Student Eligibility

- Be an underrepresented or first-generation undergraduate student attending Millersville University
- Have a cumulative grade point average 2.0 - 3.0 (at time of application)
- Have between 20-75 credits (at time of application)
- Identify a research mentor at Millersville University
- Be in residence during summer session III of 2023

Faculty Eligibility

- Applicants for research mentors must be a faculty, staff or administrator of Millersville University.
- Meet with the prospective student researcher to complete a research proposal application prior to the application deadline.
- Be engaged with the student researcher during summer session III of 2023.
