General Education Vote Results

- **Round #01 – 03/27-03/29**
 - **Voting Breakdown:**
 - f* Adopt New Gateway Model - 43.9%, 87 votes
 - f* Adopt New Journey Model - 28.3%, 56 votes
 - f* Retain Existing GenEd Program Model - 27.8%, 55 votes
 - **Details:**
 - f* The response rate was 69%.
 - f* Based on the voting protocol approved at faculty senate:
 - No option received 50% + 1 of voting faculty, therefore no model is adopted with this vote.
 - This results in a runoff vote between the two top choices: Adopt New Gateway Model and Adopt New Journey Model

 - **Voting Breakdown:**
 - f* Adopt New Gateway Model – 63.2%, 117 votes
 - f* Adopt New Journey Model – 36.8%, 68 votes
