

Standing committee of the Faculty Senate.

Membership

- 1. Chairperson
 - a. Election: Elected by Faculty Senate.
 - b. Term: Three-year term beginning and ending at the start of the fall semester in the appropriate year.
 - c. Limits: No more than two complete, consecutive terms may be served. Service of at-large or partial terms do not count towards the term limit.
 - d. **Responsibilities:** Convenes and meets with the committee on a regular basis. Attends all Faculty Senate meetings in order to act as a liaison regarding all business pertaining to the committee. Submits an annual written report, outlining the membership and work of the committee.
- 2. Faculty Representatives: Two members from each of the four academic units (Education, Humanities, Science and Mathematics, Social Sciences) and one non-school member.
 - a. Election: Elected on a staggered schedule by Faculty Senate.
 - b. Term: Two-year terms beginning and ending at the start of the fall semester of the appropriate year.
 - c. Limits: No two members may be elected from the same department. No more than two complete, consecutive terms may be served. Service of atlarge or partial terms do not count towards the term limit.
- 4. Student Representatives: Two undergraduate student representatives.
 - a. Election: Elected by Undergraduate Student Senate.
 - b. Term: One-year terms beginning and ending at the start of the fall semester of the appropriate year.
 - c. Limits: As determined by the Undergraduate Student Senate.

5. Ex Officio Members: Provost and vice president for academic affairs, General Education Coordinator, First-Year Experience Coordinator

- a. Designees: One designee may serve in lieu of each Ex Officio member.
- b. Voting: Ex Officio members/designees are non-voting members.

Functions

1. Promote understanding of the purpose of General Education, consistent with the MU mission and the specific learning needs of MU
