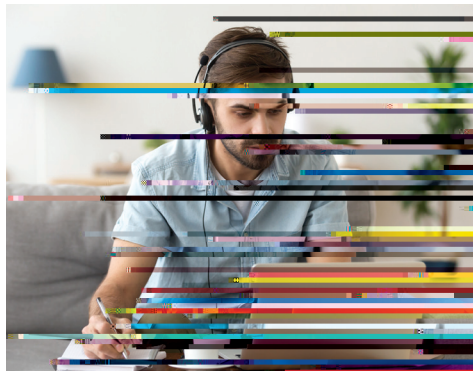


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PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- **Electives (21 credits):**
 - Narrative Courses (6-9 credits)**
 - Writing Studies Courses (6-9 credits)**
 - Credit Electives (3 credits)**
 - Capstone Project (3 credits)**
