The Master's of Education School Counseling program at Millersville University offers a 39-credit program with an option for PDE (Pennsylvania Department of Education) Certification in School Counseling (12 credit hours). It can be completed as a 51-credit master's degree, which can be counted towards licensed professional counselor eligibility in the future.

Requirements for the Program

- GRE or MAT, required only if cumulative GPA is lower than 3.0
- Three references with at least one academic reference
- Personal interview
- Six undergraduate credits in psychology

Features of Our Program




- Provides candidates with a multidisciplinary approach to school

- **January 15** – For upcoming fall semester
- **October 1** – For upcoming spring semester
