Requirements for the Program


- GRE or MAT, required only if cumulative GPA is lower than 3.0
- · Three references with at least one academic reference
- · Personal interview
- Six undergraduate credits in psychology

Application Deadline

School counseling is one of the graduate programs at Millersville University with an application deadline for each semester. Deadlines are:

- · January 15 For upcoming fall semester
- · October 1 For upcoming spring semester

Applications received after the deadline will be deferred to the next available semester.
